Time Required	Learning Outcome/Purpose	Activities	Equipment and Resources
30 minutes 30 minutes	<p>Create awareness generate discussion around controlling settings, and being aware of the information we share online. What the information could be used for. How we stay safe and in control of our personal data so we can enjoy the access and opportunities the online world opens up to us.</p>	<p>Support young people, participants or learner to reflect on what information they are choosing to share online.</p> <p>What's your Hollywood Chocolate Flower name? Download the questionnaire Provide space and support for participants to fill in the questionnaire. When participant has completed the questionnaire give them a name from the list. Help participants to identify how their information given on the questionnaire could be used by social media platforms or by cyber criminals looking to hack accounts.</p> <p>Suggested discussion questions:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - What information do you think I know about you now, having seen your questionnaire? - Do you feel comfortable about that? - How do you think a cyber criminal could use that kind of information? - How do you think social media platforms use that kind of information? What are the benefits you get from sharing your information on these platforms? <p>Discuss weighing up the positives and negatives of sharing content. Identify ways to be in control of your information and settings to enable a positive safe use of online platforms.
